Please join us for the Charitable Trust's first major fund raising event, the programme for which has been carefully planned by Liveryman Michael Gifkins, himself a talented pianist and organist, to provide a stimulating and entertaining evening.

The programme for the evening will open with a performance by Michael of the second movement (Andante) from Bach's Italian Concerto, sometimes described as the jewel set at the centre of this much loved work. Two groups of songs will be sung by David accompanied by Anna and Michael. These will include compositions by Poulenc, Quilter and Britten. Anna and Michael will play the vigorous Duet Sonata by Poulenc and Anna will play two movements from Prokofiev's own arrangement for piano of his Romeo and Juliet suite, Juliet as a young girl and Montagues & Capulets, which reflect both the delicate and bravura aspects of Prokofiev's music. The programme will also include Mozart's Rondo in A minor and Chopin's Barcarolle.

The musical part of the evening should be complete by about 8 p.m. (there will be no interval) and we invite you to partake of refreshments afterwards.

It promises to be a relaxed, inspiring evening in the luxurious acoustic of St Mary-le-Bow. We hope that you will come in support of the Trust and invite as many of your friends and acquaintances as possible.
